
2023 Performance – AZ



Statin Therapy in Patients w/ Cardiovascular Conditions

SCAN has historically done poorly on the SPC measure. It is imperative for us to improve...and we need YOUR help.



- While we've modestly improved in the last five years, our star scores for SPC are our worst performing measure.
- Success is largely dependent upon providers (and/or pharmacists!):
 - Initiating a statin
 - Dose-adjusting a statin
 - Codifying exclusions
 - Properly coding inclusions

SCAN Statin (SPC) Campaign Our initial approach, focused on the Health Equity Index

Campaign Launch: March 2024 Outreach • SPC SRF members • Refer cases to help who are close gap in care • Consistently non-• Criteria: unreachable, • Provider fax and compliant new Rx requested phone calls to engage (CPA), dose escalation, • Non-compliant: • Member calls on non-statin etc. Medical Group Target Population Escalation

Health Equity Index Refresher

CMS will begin incorporating a Health Equity Index score as part of a Medicare Advantage plan's Star Rating.

Health Equity Index (HEI) is a CMS measure of plan performance among patients with social risk factors (SRF), defined as members who are either:

- Dual-eligible with Medicare + Medicaid
- Low-Income
- Disabled

The HEI score is calculated using the performance of the SRF population in various Star measures.

- It compares how SCAN's SRF population performs in these measures with other MA plans.
- The score also incorporates the SRF population's size

- Will take effect beginning with the 2027 Star Ratings.
 - HEI will use two years of data
 - MY2024 and MY2025 performance will drive 2027 Star Ratings
