Individuals served in 2018: **16,821**

IAH connects underserved seniors, disabled adults and their caregivers to the support they need to remain safely at direct services and resource navigation. Hallmark programs include:

COMMUNITY GIVING

2018 Total: **\$777,650**

SCAN Community Giving focuses on extending the safety net for our most vulnerable citizens. A heavy emphasis is placed on support organizations that help older adults meet their basic needs of nutrition, housing and health.



SENIOR SUPPORT SERVICES GRANTS: \$220K
Grants provide general operating funds to support senior service organizations



EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE FUNDING (EAF): \$70K
Grants provide discretionary funds to meet immediate needs



NUTRITION: \$200K
Grants provide funds for home-delivered and community meals and supports food pantries



DONATIONS: \$287,650
